As most of you are aware, Bingo is the financial mainstay of the Temple and without it, Sabbar would have a difficult time keeping the doors open. Income from Bingo presently pays all of our utilities along with most of the building repairs and other unforeseen expenses.

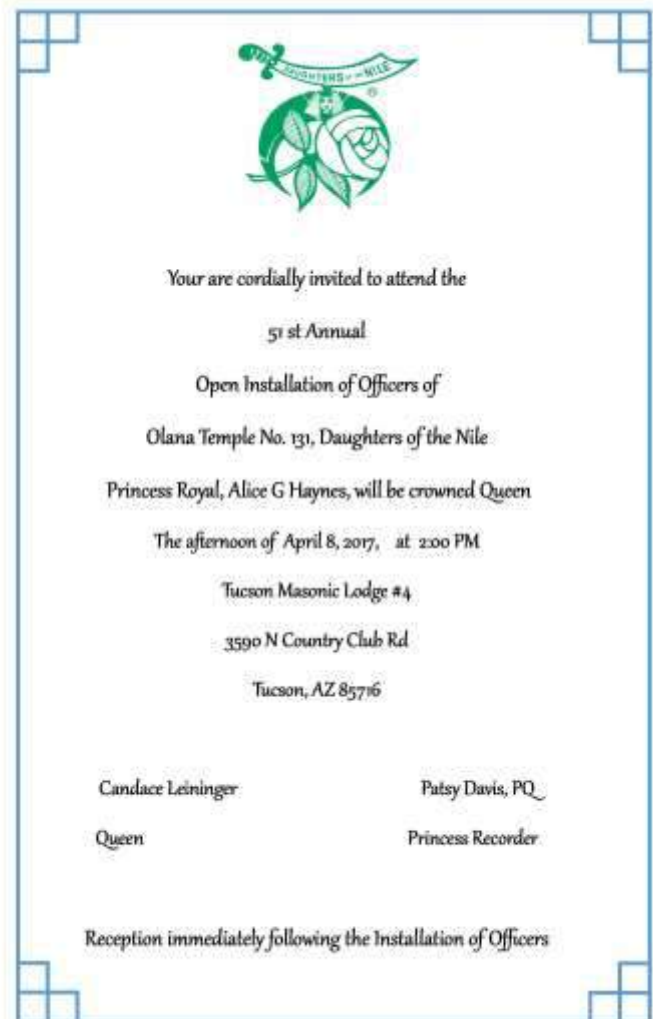
